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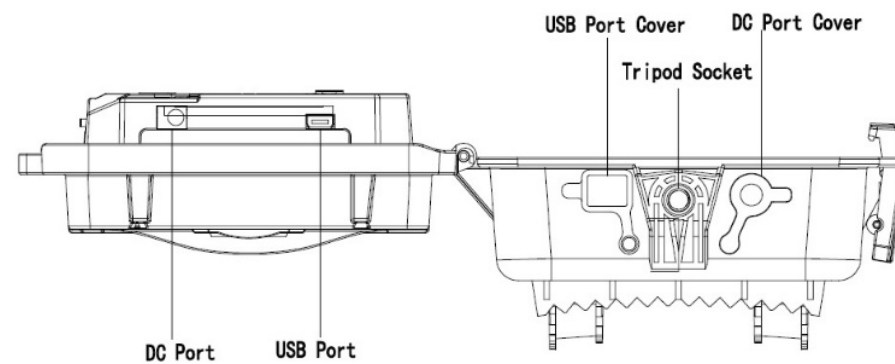
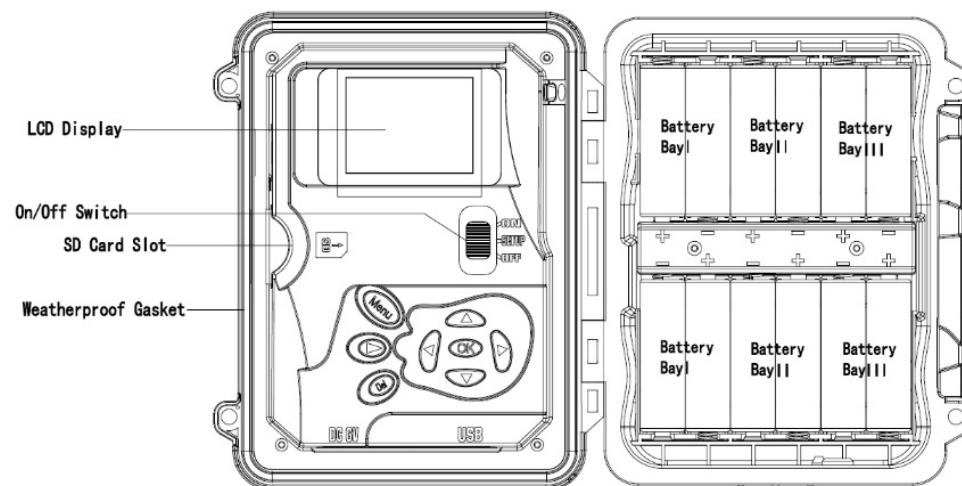
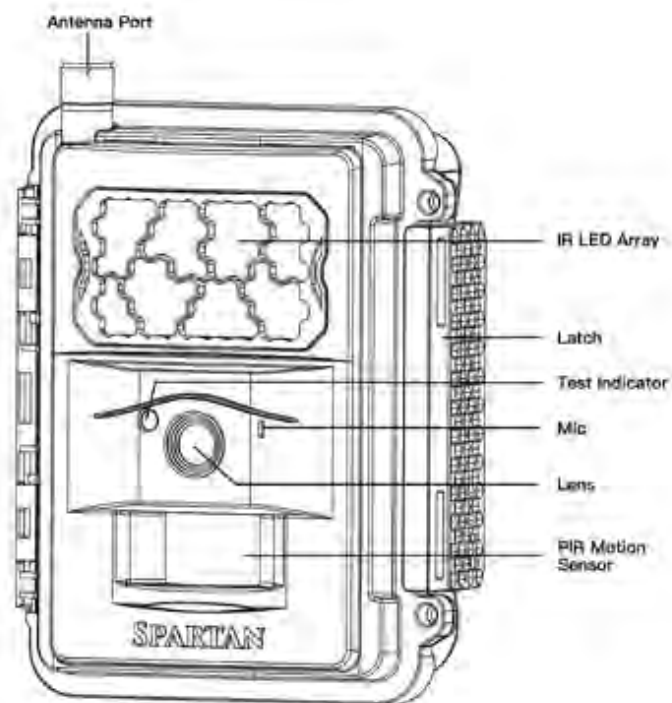
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Camera Body and Ports



Camera Buttons

- **Menu:**
 - o *Preview* mode: enter the *Setup* menu.
 - o *Setup* mode (menus): Go back one menu level. (If in a submenu, return to the main menu. If at the main menu, exit *Setup* mode.)
 - o *Playback* mode: display the *Delete* menu so you can choose to *Del One* or *Del ALL*.
- Arrows ▲ ▼ ◀ ▶:
 - o *Setup* mode: move between menu items, change values.
 - o *Playback* mode: ◀ ▶ move through photos/videos
 - o *Playback* mode, photos: ▲ zoom in, ▼ zoom out. When zoomed in, press **OK** then use ▲ ▼ ◀ ▶ to pan the image.
- **OK:**
 - o *Menu* mode: save parameter settings.
 - o *Preview* mode: take a photo or start recording a video manually.
 - o *Playback* mode, videos: play/pause video.
- Playback button ►: In the preview window, switch between *Playback* and *Preview* modes
- **Del:**
 - o *Menu* mode: when entering parameters, works as a backspace key, deletes the character to the left.
 - o *Playback* mode: delete the current photo/video.
- Shortcuts in *Preview* mode:
 - o ▲ selects *Video* mode.
 - o ▼ selects *Camera* mode.
 - o **OK** takes a picture or records a video manually.
- Mode (Power) Switch: ON at top. SETUP in the middle. OFF at the bottom.

Activation of a Network Cellular Service

A standard size network SIM card is required if you want to have photos and / or video clips delivered to email and/or your mobile device. The SIM card will have to be activated by the relevant network cellular service provider. This cellular service enables the camera to send photos and / or video clips.

Depending on your country, there are three ways to activate a cellular service. Please read how to obtain cellular network service so you can choose the one that works best for you. Before you begin, locate your camera's IMEI number, which is printed on a sticker inside the camera.

Activate at a Store

Purchase a Pay-as-you-go SIM card from your preferred network cellular service provider and have an in-store customer service rep activate the service for you.

Activate Online

If your cellular carrier offers online activation, log in to your account on your carrier's web site.

Activate by Telephone

If your cellular carrier offers telephone activation, you can activate the service by calling your carrier's support number. Listen to the menu options and follow the prompts to activate the service.

Set Up the Camera

1. With the power switch **OFF**, insert batteries into the battery compartment. Use 12 (recommended), 8, or 4 (emergency, left 2 columns) 1.2v-1.5v AA batteries.

The following types of batteries can be used:

- High-performance alkaline
- Lithium
- Rechargeable NiMH (*minimum 2600 MAh*)

For longer battery life, you can connect the camera to a 6V external battery (with or without solar panel) that is designed to be used with trail cameras.

2. Insert the SIM card.
3. Insert an *unlocked* SD card (up to 32 G, class 10 recommended) into the SD card slot. Refer to the card symbol on the case for proper orientation.
4. With the rubber gasket between the base of the antenna and the antenna jack on the top of the camera, screw the antenna onto the antenna jack. The rubber gasket must be in place to prevent leaks. Make sure the antenna is screwed in all the way but be careful not to over-tighten it.

Connect the Camera to the Cellular Network

1. Slide the power switch to the SETUP position. The camera will enter *Preview* mode.

The screen will display *Searching network...*, then *LTE* will appear at center top of the screen and the signal strength bars will show in the top right corner.

2. Press the **Menu** button to access the *Setup* menu.
3. Format the SD card: navigate to the *System* tab, then scroll down to Format, press the **OK** button, select Yes, and press the **OK** button again. *It is very important that you format the SD card in the camera before using it and it is a good idea to format it again ever so often.*

We recommend that you set up, test, and use your camera at home before deploying it, especially if this is new technology to you.

CAMERA SETUP

Overview

Here is a brief overview of how to set up your camera and get it working.

The camera can instantly send you images of activations in the following ways;

1. To mobile devices as **MMS** images (used Airtime)
 2. To **Email** addresses as images or 5sec or 10sec video clips (uses Data)
 3. To both mobile devices AND Email addresses simultaneously as MMS images (uses Airtime)
 4. Via the SPARTAN Web Portal and Mobile App (**PREMIUM**)
1. **MMS / Email**

These methods require you to use the Setup Tool Application (a pre-installed program called **WIRELESS.exe** in the camera trap) to select your preferred cellular network provider. **SOUTH AFRICA** - VODACOM, MTN, CELL C and TELKOM (8ta) can be selected from this **WIRELESS.exe** Setup Tool application.

If your Country / cellular network provider cannot be selected from the Setup Tool, you will have to input the relevant network's settings manually . PLEASE CONTACT CAMERA TRAPS cc for your relevant networks parameters.

SETUP TOOL APPLICATION PROGRAM

- a) Switch the camera to **SETUP**.
- b) Press **MENU** and navigate to the **Wireless** tab
- c) Scroll down to **Set up Tool** and press **OK**. A message will appear "The Setup Tool has been Downloaded to the SD Card"

- d) Once you have downloaded the Setup Tool to the SD card (Menu > Wireless > Setup Tool), switch the camera trap **OFF**.
- e) Take the SD card out and read the SD card from your computer. The Setup Tool application program will only work on a PC / laptop. Copy the relevant Setup Tool application program (**WIRELESS.exe** file) that is now on your SD card to your PC (*we suggest you make a separate folder on your Desktop for this*).
- f) Once copied, open (double-click) the **WIRELESS.exe** application file and you will see the setup window as below:

HOW TO SETUP YOUR SPARTAN GoCam 4G

Send Mode:

- Instant:** Select to send the images / Videos immediately.
Max Num = option to manage the number of images / clips that will get transmitted daily (0 = Unlimited).
- Daily report:** SMS notification of the number of activations that have occurred in the last 24hrs. You can set the time when you want to be notified by this SMS report.
- Off:** Turns cameras wireless function off and camera becomes a normal trail camera

Send Via:

- MMS:** Can send ONLY images to cell phones and / OR e-mail addresses (consumes AIRTIME)
- Email:** Can send images / video clips to e-mail address ONLY via the Internet (consumes DATA)
- Premium:** Available in the camera MENU settings (sends images / clips via the SPARTAN Web Portal and Mobile App)

Operator Parameters:

- Country:** Select your country from the drop down list
- Operator:** Select the relevant cellular network provider from the drop down list

If your Country / cellular network provider cannot be selected from these Setup Tool drop down lists, you will have to input the relevant network's settings manually (by clicking the 'Parameters' button). PLEASE CONTACT CAMERA TRAPS cc for your relevant networks parameters.

Send Via:

- MMS:** Can send MMS images to mobile Phones (up to 4) or Email addresses (up to 4) or Both
- Email:** Can send images or Video clips to email addresses ONLY
(5s or 10 sec video clips can ONLY be sent using Email option)
- Premium:** Available in the camera MENU settings (sends images / clips via the SPARTAN Web Portal and Mobile App)

Recipients:

Tick the boxes that you would like the recipients to receive the images and fill in their cell phone numbers (Phone1-4) and / or Email addresses (Email 1-4).
SOUTH AFRICAN cell phone numbers – input them with **NO country codes / prefixes or spaces** e.g. 0821234567

Sending images via Email to Email addresses:

In the **Send To** box click the **Email Setting** button and the following window will appear:

Here you input the Sending email account details as the camera will use this account to send the relevant images.

A number of popular Email Provider settings are pre-loaded onto the Setup Tool (Gmail / yahoo etc.) Click on the drop-down menu to select one of them.

You can also use your own existing personal e-mail settings.

To do this, select 'Other' as the Email Provider from the drop down list and fill in all the required Account / Password / SMTP Server / SMTP Port details.

PLEASE NOTE - Using Gmail: 

A standard part of internet security on the part of Google and other email processors is to keep your account safe. When you first use Gmail in your camera, Google will typically block your access. You will receive an email stating that an application or person has tried to access your account. Since the camera is sending the email the response is returned to the camera. Our server will attempt to detect this issue and send a notification email to the configured Account Email. Thus, you may receive an email from our server. With Gmail and other email services you are likely to have this problem. This is not an issue with GoWireless but is a typical issue.

Read below for steps to remedy the situation.

In order to allow the camera to use your Gmail account you will have to follow a series of steps to enable / allow other applications (or less secure Apps) to use your Gmail account.

- 1. Log onto your Gmail account via a PC or Laptop*
- 2. Click on "My Account"*
- 3. Click on "Sign-In & Security" and go to "Apps with Account access" - Click this link*
- 4. Scroll down to the "Less secure Apps" button and switch it from OFF to ON.*
- 5. Log off and you are done.*

Image Quality:

Normal / High: Minimized images are transmitted via MMS / Email / Premium modes (640 x 480 pixels) = 40kb - 70kb.

The original size images are saved to the SD card

Image From:

Input a label (max 15 characters) for the camera. This will be imprinted on the MMS photo and / or email subject line so the user will know where (which camera) the images have come from.

Realtime:

Enables camera to be constantly "ON" and awake to react instantly to remote SMS Commands sent by the user to control functions / change settings of the camera (details below). This can also be changed in the camera trap Menu.

Status Response:

If checked, the camera will send the user a return SMS confirming the command - **whether sending via MMS or Email** (*User must have a valid cell phone number input for **Phone1** for this function to operate*)

"Save" button

Press the 'Save' button and a binary file (**MMSCFG.BIN**) will be saved in the same location from where you opened up the Wireless.exe Application Setup Program (from on your computer as we recommended earlier).

- Copy this binary file (**MMSCFG.BIN**) onto a formatted SD card and insert it into the camera trap.
- Turn the camera to 'SETUP' and a series of 3 x quick beeps directly followed by 2 x slower beeps will be heard. *These 2 x slower beeps indicate that the new parameters and settings have been successfully updated.*

"Default" button

By pressing this, the default Wireless Setup Toolsettings will be loaded.

"Load" button

For ease of use, select this option if you want to amend any parameters, phone or e-mail settings.

It will ask you to navigate and select which binary file (**MMSCFG.BIN**) to be loaded into the Wireless Setup Tool.

"Cancel" button

Closes the Wireless.exe Application program.

Programming is now complete. It is recommended to setup the camera in an area with good cellular signal and test before deploying.

SMS Remote Control

The Spartan® 4G wireless camera can be remotely controlled by sending SMS commands to the camera's SIM card phone number (PLEASE NOTE: SOME CELLULAR TOWERS DO NOT SUPPORT ALL COMMANDS). If the unit sends you a text response of "Network Busy" this means the tower/service area does not support the command. This is not a manufacturer/camera issue).

The Commander Phone Number - The Recipient **Phone1** will be the commander phone numbers *i.e. the one that can control the camera via SMS commands.*

Power Saving - In order to use the SMS remote control function, the user needs to set the switch to **OFF** in the setup process.

Status Response (SMS) - In order to use the SMS control function, the user needs to tick this box in the setup process. If checked, the camera will send The Commander Phone Number (Phone1) a return SMS confirming the command - **whether sending via MMS or Email** (*User must have a valid cell phone number input for Phone1 for this function to operate*).

3. **PREMIUM** - Using the SPARTAN Web Portal and Mobile App

- Register your camera by having it connect to the web portal.
- Add your camera to your account on the web portal.
- Specify the camera settings using the web portal.
- Install the app on your mobile device.

These are the minimum steps to get camera setup completed and working. Photos from your camera will be uploaded and stored on your Spartan Camera account for 30 days. Important: Each night, the oldest photos (31 days and older) will be automatically purged from the server.

This is a more detailed list of steps to complete setup:

Add Camera to the Web Portal

1. Using a web browser on your computer or phone, go to www.spartancamera.com.
2. Sign in to your account. If you don't already have an account, register for one, then sign in.
3. To set your time zone:
 - a. From the main menu, *MY ACCOUNT > ACCOUNT OPTIONS*.
 - b. Select the region and the time zone, then click the *Update* button.
4. To add your camera:
 - a. From the main menu, select *MY CAMERAS > MANAGEMENT*.
 - b. Click the *Add New Camera* button.
 - c. Move the camera switch to **SETUP** and when you have a signal, press the **Menu** button then select the *Wireless* menu.
 - d. Verify that *Send Mode* is *Instant*.
 - e. Select *Register Camera*, press **OK**, and wait several seconds. If registration is successful, the camera screen will show your Module ID (IMEI) and the registration code. If registration is not successful, repeat this step.
 - f. On the portal *Add New Camera* page, type a description for the camera that will help you to identify it. This is especially important if you have more than one. If you want the cameras listed in a particular order in the phone app, assign names that will sort in alphabetical/numerical order (e.g., 01 SE corner, 02 NE corner, etc.)
 - g. Input both the Module ID and the Registration Code.
 - h. Check the box to agree to the terms of use and privacy policy.
 - i. Click the *Add this Camera* button.

5. If you input the values correctly, you will return to the *CAMERA MANAGEMENT* page on the web portal.
6. Send a Test Picture: in *Preview* mode, press **OK** to take a picture then **OK** again to send it.
7. If you can see the picture on the *MY CAMERAS > CAMERA MANAGEMENT* or *MANAGE PHOTOS* page, service is working. All you need to do is to customize the setup for your particular needs by updating camera settings, adding email contacts, etc..

Complete Camera Setup on the Portal

Complete these steps on the portal to finish the setup.

1. Verify that you have credits on your account: Select *MY ACCOUNT > PREMIUM CREDIT HISTORY* and verify that you have at least one credit. Adding a brand new camera will add a free credit to your account.
2. Change your camera settings: *MY CAMERAS > CAMERA SETTINGS*
 - a. Set the *region* and *time zone*. The time zone must be set in order for your camera to function properly.
 - b. Choose and set all the settings you want to use.
 - c. It is recommended that you set several scheduled events, either status reports or photos. There are nine available events for you to set, plus the default daily status report that you can set the time for. You will probably want to use most or all of available events at least for status reports throughout the day so that you don't have to wait too long to get requested HD photos or video downloads.

You may want to set some scheduled events to take photos at specific times (e.g., 9 AM and 9 PM so that you will get at least two pictures every day). This is especially useful if your camera is in a low-traffic area. The scheduled photos are reassurance that your camera is still there and is still working.

- d. When you are done, click *Schedule a Settings Update*.
- e. To force the camera to contact the server and update settings, take and send a manual photo (in **SETUP** mode, **OK**, **OK**. Watch the screen and after the photo is sent, you will see a message that the settings have been updated.)

3. Update the camera firmware if your camera's firmware is not the latest version:
 - a. On the portal, select *MY CAMERAS > FIRMWARE UPDATE*.
 - b. Compare the date of the firmware version listed for your camera to the date of the latest version.
 - c. If the latest version is more recent than the one on your camera, click *Update*.
 - d. Take and send another manual photo. After the screen says the photo has been sent, it will indicate that it is downloading and updating the FW, then it will restart and come back up in setup mode.

Test the Camera and Portal

1. Turn your camera on and walk test it or set it for time-lapse mode with a short trigger interval.
2. View the photos on the web portal:
 - a. Select *MY CAMERAS > CAMERA MANAGEMENT* or *MANAGE PHOTOS*.
 - b. Refresh the browser periodically or check your email.
3. Request a status report:
 - a. While you are testing the camera, select *MY CAMERAS > MANAGEMENT*.
 - b. Click the *Manage Camera* dropdown then click *Request Status*.
 - c. Refresh the browser periodically. The pending request is listed under *Pending Actions* until it's complete, then it will be listed if you drop down *COMMAND HISTORY*. You will also receive a status report via email if you entered an email address for *Email to Send Status Reports* on the *MY CAMERAS > DELIVERY OPTIONS* page.

Install and Set Up the Mobile App

Overview: The following basic steps will get the app working on your device.

- On the web portal, specify admin and guest access codes.
 - On your mobile device, download and install the app from either Google Play Store or Apple App Store.
 - Using the mobile app, authenticate to connect the app to your Spartan Camera account.
1. On the web portal, set up both admin and guest access codes:
 - a. Select *MY CAMERAS > MOBILE ACCESS*.
 - b. Enter an *Admin Access Code* and (optionally, if you want to share pictures but not camera control with guests) a *Guest Access Code*. You

can use different admin and guest access codes for different cameras or groups of cameras if you want to share access with different groups of people. Most people will probably want to use the same admin code for all their cameras.

- c. Click the *Update* button.
- d. Make a note of your Account ID, the Admin Access Code and the Guest Access Code.

2. On your mobile device, go to the appropriate app store and search for the "Spartan Camera management" app (from Frontier Pursuits Technology).



3. Download and install the app.
4. Launch the Spartan Camera mobile app. Read the quick tip, then close it.
5. To connect the app to your Spartan Camera account:
 - a. From the menu, tap *Camera Management*.
 - b. Tap **+** to open the authentication dialog.
 - c. Enter the Account ID and the Access Code (the admin code for your phone, guest code for people who you don't want controlling the camera).
 - d. Tap *Add*.
6. Return to the main screen. If your phone is connected to WiFi, your pictures should appear.
7. Check the following settings and change if appropriate:
 - a. Tap the *Menu* button.
 - b. Tap *Mobile Settings*.
 - c. Under *When New Photo is Available*, you will probably want *Automatically Download* set to ON and *Download Only When WiFi is Available* set to OFF. If the WiFi setting is OFF, photos and videos will download whether you are on WiFi or not, but be aware that downloads will use your device's data allowance if WiFi is not available. Thumbnails typically are small, but if you download a lot of them and/or a lot of hi-res photos or videos, this may be a consideration for you.
 - d. Set *Photos – Auto Purge Days* to your desired value. This purges photos only from your device, not from the portal.

Complete Physical Camera Setup

1. After setting up and testing the camera, position it on the target area and turn it on by sliding the power switch to ON. *Please remember to switch from SETUP to ON after the camera logs into the network.* The camera will take pictures or videos as programmed. The height you mount your camera depends on what your targets are, but 2-4 feet off the ground is generally best for wildlife, depending on what size animals you are want to photograph.
2. The green light on the front of the camera should flash for a few seconds to give you time to move out of the area. If it continues to flash for more than a few seconds, you have left the camera in *SETUP* mode rather than turning it ON.
3. *Important:* When you are ready to retrieve the SD card or change the settings, turn the camera off first by pushing the power switch to the OFF position.

Even in the OFF mode, the camera consumes a small amount of battery power. You should remove the batteries if the camera will not be in use for an extended time.

Camera Settings

Press the **Menu** button to access the *Setup* menu. Navigate the menus using the following keys:

- Press ◀ or ▶ to move between the tabs (submenus).
- Press ▲ or ▼ move among the submenu items.
- Press ◀ or ▶ to change the value for an item.
- Press the **OK** button to save all changes you've made to settings in a tab.
- Press **Menu** return to the main menu (tabs) or to exit *Setup* mode (back one level).

Test the Camera

Photo, instant send mode

1. Press the **OK** button to take a picture.
2. Press the **OK** button to send the picture to the portal/app or the **Menu** button not to send the photo.

Photo, daily report or send mode off

1. Press the **OK** button to take a picture.
2. Review the picture using the instructions that appear later in this section.

Video

1. Press the **OK** button to start recording a video. The camera will record video until you stop it or it runs out of storage space on the SD card; the video length you set does not apply to manually-recorded videos.
2. Press the **OK** button to stop recording the video.

Access Photos or Videos

5. With an empty SD card (preferably one that was formatted in your camera) in your computer's SD card reader, copy the file from your computer to the SD card. It should not be inside any folder on the card.
6. Insert the SD card back into the camera.
7. To apply the firmware, with the camera in **SETUP** mode:
 - a. Press the **Menu** button.
 - b. On the *System* tab, select *FW Update*, press **OK**, select *Yes*, press **OK**, then watch the screen for progress. When the FW update is complete, the camera will restart.
8. Reload the camera defaults:
 - a. Press the **Menu** button.
 - b. On the *System* tab, select *Default*, press **OK**, then select *Yes*.
9. On the *System* tab, choose *Information* and verify the firmware version has changed.
10. Reset your camera's settings. Request a setting update on the app or portal, then take and send a manual photo.

Terms and Conditions

Spartan Camera (SC) warrants our Spartan Camera products against defects in material or workmanship for a period of two years from the original date of purchase of the product by a consumer (the "Warranty Period"). If a material or workmanship defect arises with regard to any Spartan Camera, and a valid claim is received within the Warranty Period, SC will (1) repair the camera using new or refurbished parts or (2) replace the camera with a new or refurbished product. For purposes of this limited warranty, "refurbished" means a product or part that has been substantially returned to its original specifications. In the event of a defect, these are your exclusive remedies. The warranty on any replacement product provided under this warranty shall be for the unexpired portion of the warranty period applicable to the original product.

The warranty agreement, as defined here, is the sole controlling terms. No other warranty information as published by SC, relating to other products, applies to the Spartan Camera series.

Shipping

Initial shipping of items to SC for warranty coverage is the responsibility of the customer. SC has no responsibility for any items lost or damaged during incoming shipment. It is recommended that all shipments made by the customer be insured. Before shipping any items for warranty coverage, an RMA must be obtained via phone or the SC website. Any items received without a valid RMA may result in delays in service or loss of the item. If your RMA is approved, your RMA number is only valid for 30 days from the date of issue, and only for items originally listed on the RMA request form. In addition SC reserves the right to charge a small shipping and handling fee in connection with the fulfillment of any valid claim. Please include \$11.95 for return shipping & insurance. (For U.S. customers only. CHECK OR MONEY ORDER ONLY, NON-REFUNDABLE). International customers pay different amount of shipping & insurance. We will send detailed information along with the RMA number.

Proof of Purchase or Proof of Warranty Coverage

We pride ourselves on providing top-quality scouting cameras for your hunting, research and security needs, and take quality seriously. We are constantly evolving our designs to ensure our products do the best job possible. When requesting warranty coverage, we may require the following:

- a) Warranty registration within 30 days of the original purchase date, via mail in warranty card or online at the SC website is **required** for warranty coverage to be valid.
- b) We may require proof that the claim is valid.
