

How to install CamCtrl_M APK file on Android devices

An Android app package file (.apk) is a file format used to install an App on Android devices. In order to install an .apk file to the Android device, basically you need to do the following.

1. On your Android device, navigate to 'Apps' > 'Settings' > 'Security', enable 'Unknown Sources', then tap 'OK' to agree to enable this setting. This will allow the installation of third party apps and standalone APK's.
2. Download the **CamCtrl_M_2.3.1021.zip file folder to your PC** by clicking [here](#). *You can simply save it to the desktop.*
3. Unzip / Extract the 'CamCtrl_M_2.3.1021.zip' folder and the **CamCtrl_M_2.3.1021.apk** file is in this folder.
4. Connect your Android device to the PC using a USB cable. At this point, it will ask you if you want to charge your device or connect it as a 'Media device', select 'Media device'.
5. Navigate to the **CamCtrl_M_2.3.1021.apk** file on the PC and copy this file into a folder in your Android device. It can be stored in the internal storage or the external storage of your Android device.
6. After that, you need to open the Android device's file manager to locate the **CamCtrl_M_2.3.1021.apk** file. It's usually called My Files, or File Browser, and you'll typically find it in the app drawer.
Note: If there is no file manager app installed yet, you can download a free file manager app from the Play Store, such as ES File Explorer.
6. On the Android device, tap on the APK file you just copied, it will ask if you want to install the app, just confirm and proceed, once it's finished, tap the 'Done' button and the new app is ready to use!
